Meetings in room 207, one Friday every month. Listen for announcements or ask teacher(s).



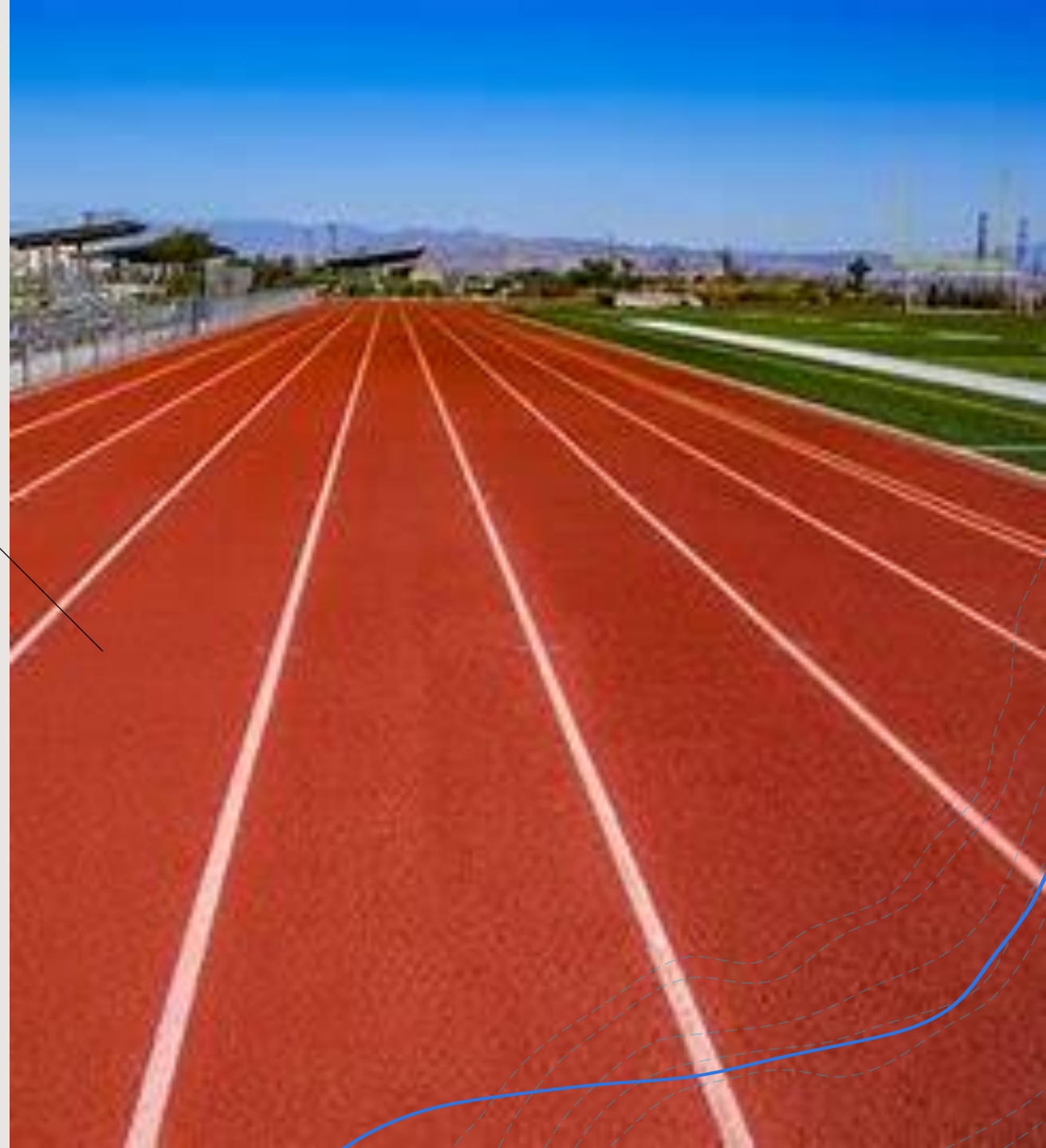
Cross Country / Track & Field

Runs once a week on Thursdays at lunch in the theatre/open area. Listen for announcements or ask teacher(s).

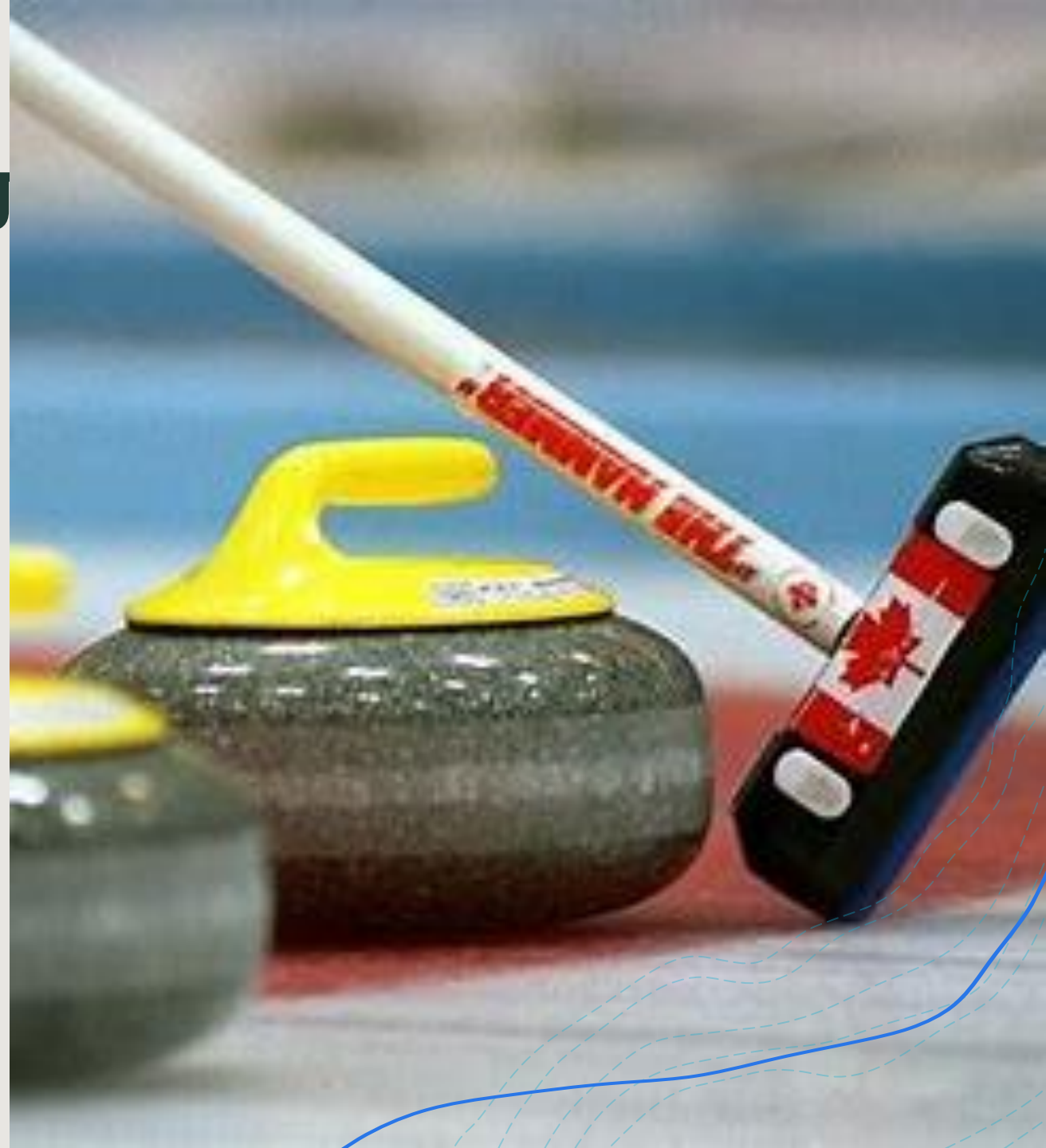

This club will meet on Fridays at lunch in room 215. Starting in October, See Mr. Sun for more details.



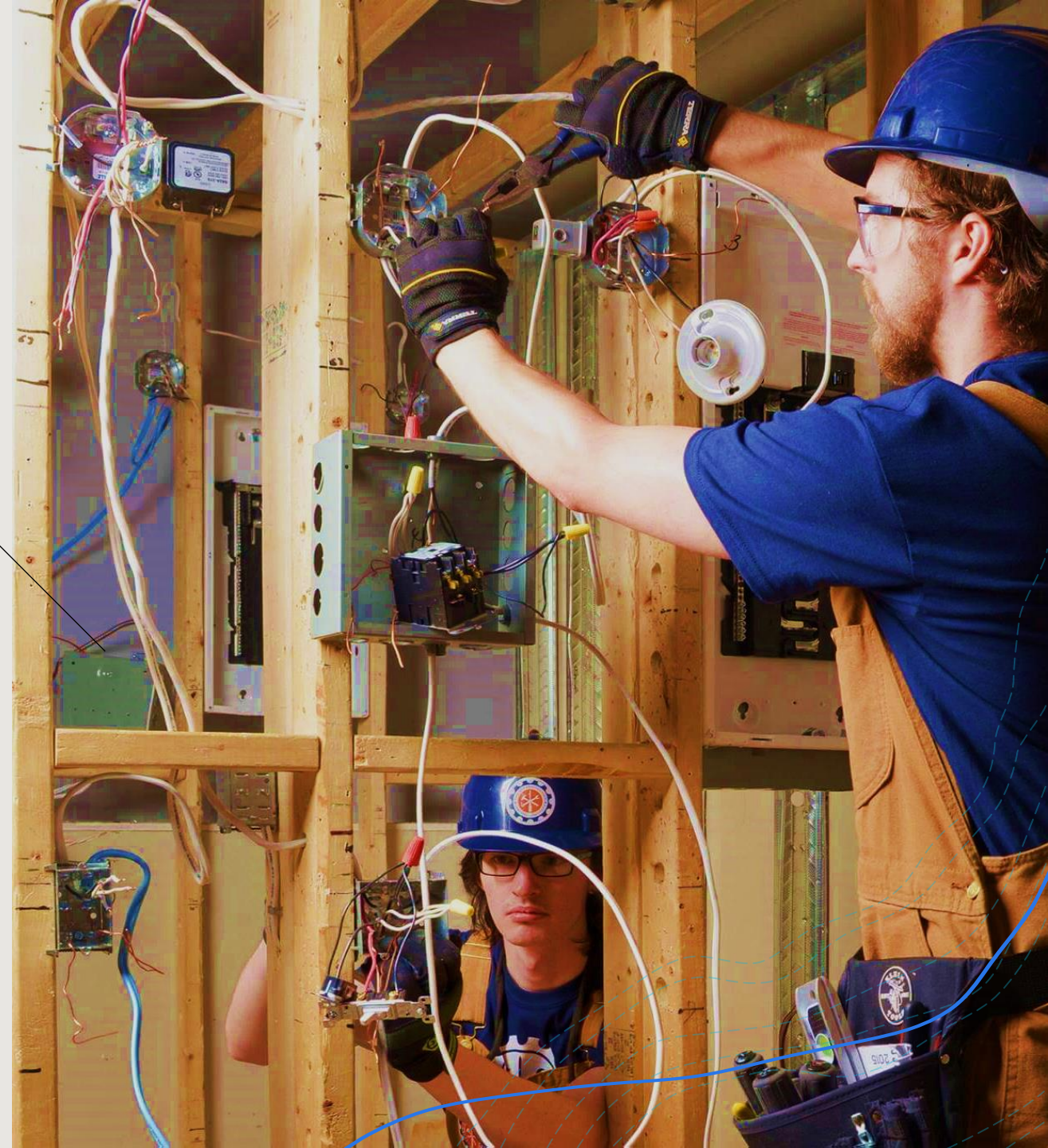
Electrical Club
