WHO ARE WE?

We are Adult Learning on Lombard, a space for adult learners who are 19+ and wanting to attend literacy programming, take high school English and math courses, or look to attain a mature high school diploma in a supported environment.

WHAT DO WE DO?

We provide school programming for adult learners who are on Employment and Income Assistance (EIA) or at risk of being on EIA to upgrade their schooling.

WHERE ARE WE LOCATED?

We are located at 111 Lombard Ave. on the third floor in Room 320.

You can start anytime! Our school hours are 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday.

MISSION STATEMENT

Adult Learning on Lombard works to create a safe, inclusive, supportive environment that engages and empowers each student to grow as a lifelong learner, family member, worker, and community member.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR REFERRING SERVICE PARTNERS

Adult Learning on Lombard is a full-time day program (with continuous intake) for adults who are either on EIA or at risk of being on EIA to upgrade their education. We focus on English literacy, math, and computer use.

Each student will have an individualized learning plan and students can work at their own pace. Each student will also have their own wellness skills supports facilitator, who will help them set goals, work on personal barriers, or assist in any area of well-being.

Adult Learning on Lombard offers a variety of opportunities to enhance the student experience. These include participating in field trips, cooking classes, arts and crafts, and wellness-based activities. During the summer, Adult Learning on Lombard provides students with a full-time summer program, focusing on financial literacy, resumé writing, music classes, and wellness topics.

Students have earned certificates during summer programming through our partnerships with other community-based programs.
