Post Secondary Education/Bursaries Information

Louis Riel Bursary

The Louis Riel Bursary is available to Red River Métis students at several post-secondary institutions across Manitoba and are administered through the Louis Riel Institute in partnership with the post-secondary institutions.

Qualified students are required to complete an application that may be one or two parts—depending on their individual post-secondary institute. The Louis Riel Institute will confirm an applicant's eligibility for the bursary through verification of Manitoba Métis Federation citizenship and the post-secondary institutions determine the bursary recipients based on their individual assessment criteria.

The Red River Métis & Cantor's Family Award

The Red River Métis & Cantor's Family Award is available to Red River Métis students who are attending a post-secondary institution in Manitoba. The student must be enrolled in butcher/abattoir, culinary arts, or any agricultural programs which focus on the study of livestock and processes used for the purpose of feeding people or a related field in which you can express the connection to the butcher/abattoir field.

Qualified students are encouraged to complete an application, provide a copy of an acceptance letter from their institution, three letters of recommendation, and a 500+ word essay.

Audreen Hourie Governance Fellowship

The Audreen Hourie Governance Fellowship is available to Red River Métis students enrolled at the University of Winnipeg and administered through the Louis Riel Institute. Students accepted into the Masters of Aboriginal Governance or Masters of Development Practice, who are involved in the community, and who show finance need are encouraged to apply.

Qualified students are required to complete an application through the University of Winnipeg. Each fellowship will be assessed on an individual basis and are directly linked to an applicant's enrollment.

The Senator Gerry & Margaret St. Germain Bursary

The Senator Gerry & Margaret St. Germain Bursary is available to Gr. 12 Red River Métis students across Manitoba who excel in Math/or Science and are involved in the community.

Qualified students are encouraged to complete an application, provide a transcript or statement of marks from their most recent year, provide two letters of recommendation, and an essay.

Mary Guilbault Bursary

The Mary Guilbault Bursary is available to Red River Métis students across Manitoba who excel in academics and the community and who show financial need.

Qualified students are encouraged to complete an application, provide a transcript or statement of marks from their most recent year, provide two letters of recommendation, and an essay.

MMF Vickar Community Chevrolet Award

The Vickar Community Chevrolet Award is available to Red River Métis students enrolled at Red River College Polytech in one of the following programs:

- Automotive Technician (Diploma or Certificate)
- Business Administration
- Commerce, Industry Sales & Marketing
- Introduction to Trades (Automotive)
- Collision Repair & Refinishing

Qualified students are required to complete a two-part application through Red River College Polytech and the Louis Riel Institute. Each bursary will be assessed on an individual basis.

Students are eligible to apply for the award every year they are enrolled in their program.
