KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Kindergarten registration is open for all children born in 2017. This means that your child must have had their fifth birthday on or before December 31, 2022.

Registration will start on Monday, March 7th by appointment only.

Kindergarten registration forms are available on our school webpage. You will need to bring the completed registration forms to the registration appointment. If you prefer, you can complete the fillable registration forms and email them to the school prior to your appointment. School email is: <u>idg@retsd.mb.ca</u>

You can call 204-669-1280 to book your appointment. Appointments will run until June 28th.

At the registration appointment, you will need to bring the following:

- Completed John de Graff School Registration form (1/child)
- 2 pieces of identification regarding proof of address (e.g. Driver's license, Utility Bill, Tenancy Agreement, Offer to Purchase)
- 1 piece of identification regarding your child's proof of age (e.g. birth certificate, baptismal certificate, Passport, Treaty Card)
- In-Division Out of Designated School Boundary form (if applying for another school in the division).

Please pass this information to any neighbours or friends who have children ready for Kindergarten, who do not receive this newsletter due to not having children attending John de Graff School. Thank you for your help.

John de Graff School is <u>closed</u> to "School of Choice" for the 2022-23 school year.

IN-DIVISION OUT OF DESIGNATED SCHOOL BOUNDARY Parents/Guardians do have the ability to make a request that their child attend a different school from the one designated by their home address by the school division. In-Division out of Designated School Boundary requests for students living within the River East Transcona School Division will be accepted starting March 7th, 2022. Request forms can be obtained from our school website located under Registrations or at any school in the division; however, parents must hand in the form along with the registration at their designated school. The designated school will then notify the school of choice about the request. Applicants will be notified as to whether or not they have been accepted into the school of choice.


Fee-For-Service applications must be submitted to the Transportation Department by **June 30th** of each school year. Applications received after June 30th will be reviewed on an individual basis.

The results have been tabulated and the grade 3's at JDG have spoken! Here are the 2022 winners of our Annual Battle of the Books:



Students who have read 3 books get 1 vote.


Students who have read 4-6 books get 2 votes.

Titles are available in the classroom libraries, public library and on SORA (our online library accessed through Office 365).





BUS EVACUATION DRILLS

COVID MEASURES RECOMMENDED AT THE DATE OF EVACUATION DRILLS WILL BE IN EFFECT

The Public Schools Act, P250-R.M. 465/88 R - Pupil Instruction, states the following:

"The school board shall ensure that at least twice in each school year each pupil is instructed in safe school bus riding practices and participates in emergency school bus evacuation drills which shall be conducted at least once during the fall term and at least once during the spring term of each school year."

The River East Transcona Transportation Department has an excellent safety record.

In maintaining this record, we carry out Bus Evacuation programs in all of our schools in the early fall and late spring of each school year.

These practice drills are carried out so that in the event of an emergency, our students can evacuate the bus as quickly and safely as possible.

The safety of our children is of the utmost importance and must be given first consideration.
