


Welcome to the March 6, 2023 Wayoata School Community Council.




## Current Extra-Curricular schedule is as follows:

- Mindful Coloring Clubs were made available to the varying grade levels




New students attending Busy Builders Club! What a great way to help new students develop a sense of belonging to our Wayoata School community.




Throughout the month of February, Wayoata School staff and students celebrated Black History Month.




Sharing of books, websites, and webinars celebrating black lives, black history and black authors.




They were a great addition to our list of special presenters for the I Love to Read Month.




James Teitsma MLA for Radisson joined us as an I LOVE to READ guest reader.



Ms. Johnson's class has been enjoying reading around the school during I Love to Read month.




In particular, they enjoyed reading in their pyjamas and with flashlights too!




The Grade 4 and 5's attended the Festival du Voyageur on February 21st.






On Thursday, March 2<sup>nd</sup> the Grade 3 and 4 students had a fieldtrip to the Planetarium and the Manitoba Museum.




Mr. Behrens' grade 3 class show here on their Museum fieldtrip.



Grade 3's enjoying the Children's Museum learning to reuse, recycle and garbage activity and engaging in the Hydro Workshop.




Both Mr. Behrens' and Mrs. Veryha's classes enjoyed a fieldtrip and expanding upon their classroom learning.

One thing is for certain...so much fun was had by all!





- -Pick-up day is May 31st in the school gymnasium between 3:00 pm 6:00 pm




What's happening in March in regards to the student registration and transitions?
