




Welcome to the May 1st, 2023 Wayoata School Community Council.




Salisbury House Hot Lunch is scheduled for Thursday, May 18th and orders are due by May 4th.






Each class received a bucket of large chalk to decorate the sidewalk in front of the school and on our community sidewalks sharing positive and kind messages.




Besides the colourful art work, the student shared messages such as: be kind, believe in you, you're enough, smile, have fun, be yourself, love yourself and others.






During Ukrainian Club, students painted Pysanka which are traditional Easter eggs.




Mrs. Johnson's Grade 1 / 2 class were busy reading and writing around the building.



They moved around the school to the Library, and other nooks and crannies, and even had opportunity to read and write in the staff room.








