  - Registrations for 2022-2023 school have gone out. Due end of May 2022.

  - Lunch Program supervisors are fully staffed
  - CPR completed.
  - Committee is looking for another member to join, currently 3 members & school representative (Joanne S., Amanda D., Melissa W., and principle Anita M)
  - Meetings are monthly and one hour long, usually same week as PAC
- 5.2 Fundraising (Amanda/Julie/Melissa):
  - Bike raffle for playground, will apply for a raffle license for June 9, 2022.
- 5.3 Hot lunch (Joanne/Julie):
  - Deferred discussion to 2022/2023 school year.
- 6. Playground Committee –(Julie/Melissa/Kori/Monica)

- \$13,183.00 in Playground Fund
- Bryan from Playgrounds R Us provided some drawings and a quote for the North Playground (Grade 4-5 side). The quote was for \$202,615.95 and included removing existing surfacing and structures, replacing stones with engineered wood fibar system (including drainage system), new play structure and swings, and wooden border (similar to what we currently have).
- Some changes to the design were sent back to try and bring costs down, information should be available on May 20th,2022.
- Originally new design was requested for the South Playground (K-3 side) too, but based on the quote, it was asked if he could find a way to add swings to the area which would fit into a plan when we replace that play structure. He mentioned if we were to add the swings to the area where they currently are the 2 trees behind would have to be removed as they wouldn't meet today's standards for clearance. (One of the trees doesn't look the healthiest. Not sure if we are interested in removing them?).
- Proposed idea is replace the swings on the South side first, and then focus on raising money for the North play structure. After the updated drawings and quote are received a meeting with Anita, Marnie (and whoever else would like from the school), playground committee and Bryan to further discuss the plans will be set-up
- Grants and RETSD requires three quotes from the architect firms, and with the landscapes
- Need to get quotes and designs to send to RETSD, RETSD chooses architect firm.
