

Easiest & Fastest Way to Access your Child's Report Card

1. The Parent Portal site: https://tyler.retsd.mb.ca/TSI_Live_360/

3. Your computer will need to have Adobe Acrobat installed to view the report card documents. This can be downloaded for free from: <https://get.adobe.com/reader/>
4. Instructions for access from your mobile device: [Mobile Application Instructions.pdf](#).
5. **Password Reset**
 - A. The portal login screen does have a "Forgot your password" link.
 - B. Users should be able to have their account reset if they have an email address on file.
 - C. If the user has forgotten their password and doesn't have an email address on file, they will need to contact the school.
6. Data Errors - If student contacts find any errors in the data (attendance, report cards, etc.) please notify the school office.

In 2000, our Breakfast Program started by serving one student cereal with milk out of a classroom. It has evolved over the years, and is now a perfected cart system that serves 90 to 120 students per day.

- Three staff members greet students and hand out meals every morning at 8:50 am

- Grades Kindergarten through 8

- Over 16 000 meals served every school year







NOTICE TO GRADE 6 STUDENTS RE BUSING

Grade 6 students transported by RETSD School Bus will not be eligible for busing in Grade 7. According to the Manitoba Education Public Schools Act Regulation (M.R. 259/2006) Grade 7 to Grade 12 students living within the city limits are not eligible for School Bus Transportation. Fee-for-Service may be available. If you are considering this option, submit a Transportation Application – Fee-For-Service 2019-2020 form. Forms are available from the school office or follow the Quick Link “Busing Information” on the RETSD website at www.retsd.mb.ca

Fee-For-Service applications must be submitted to the Transportation Department by **June 30th** of each school year. Applications received after June 30th will be reviewed on an individual basis.

NOTICE RE FEE-FOR-SERVICE BUSSING

If you are requiring Fee-For-Service transportation, the application form must be submitted to Transportation Dept. **each school year**.
