It is beneficial for all when you register your kindergarten student early:

- It is helpful in school classroom planning, for determining class sizes and teachers
- * It is helpful for the parent in preparing their child for the school environment and avoiding the last minute rush
- * It is helpful for the student to come to the Kindergarten Orientation and meet the teacher and see the classroom

In order to register your child for Kindergarten, THE FOLLOWING IDENTIFICATION IS REQUIRED:

TWO (2) PIECES OF PROOF OF RESIDENCY:

This can be your Manitoba Medical Card, driver's license, lease agreement or current offer to purchase (duly signed), or current utility bill (name and corresponding address)

ONE (1) PIECE OF PROOF OF AGE:

This can be your child's birth certificate, passport, baptismal papers, passport, health card, treaty card, or record of live birth. (Your child has to have been born in 2018, turning 5 years of age before December 31, 2023)

Please pass this information on to any families that you know has a child eligible to register for Kindergarten for the 2023-2024 school year.

PARENTING FOR PREVENTION

HOW TO TALK WITH YOUR EARLY/MIDDLE YEARS YOUTH ABOUT SUBSTANCE USE



Parents and caregivers can have the biggest influence in aiding their child in making decisions about substance use.
