2 Pieces Proof of Residency:

- Driver's license
- Manitoba Health Card
- Tenancy agreement (duly signed)
- Offer to purchase documents (completed with signatures)
- Utility bill (name and corresponding address)

1 Piece Proof of Age:

- Birth Certificate
- Passport
- Manitoba Health Card
- Treaty Card
- Baptismal Certificate
- Certificate of Birth registration, signed by Director of Vital Statistics

In-Division, Out-of-Designated School Boundary

Parents/Guardians have the ability to make a request that their child attend a school outside their catchment. Parents must submit School of Choice forms with the registration at their designated, catchment school. Seeds from Kids Fundraiser

What's Happening?

Donwood School is working with Seeds from Kids to provide quality garden seeds to the community, while raising money for outdoor education at Donwood School.

Who is Seeds from Kids?

Seeds from Kids started as a small local venture with kids from Donwood School! What started as an educational project literally blossomed into something wonderful. Seeds are collected primarily by hand from gardens in Winnipeg and southern Manitoba. Most seeds have been grown in uncertified organic gardens and have been scientifically tested for seed viability. A few machine collected seeds (such as carrots and parsley) are sourced from T&T Seeds.

What to Expect:

Seeds will come in simple packaging featuring kid artists from Donwood Elementary. Seed amounts for each plant are similar to packages from common seed sellers that are sold at grocery stores.

Why Choose this Fundraiser:

Unlike other fundraisers, Seeds from Kids is offering their full net proceeds to Donwood Elementary, so getting outdoor classroom and recess equipment into our children's hands can happen quickly. This fundraiser is environmentally friendly and is empowering to the classes learning about these seeds and plants! Our students are taking ownership of this fundraiser and are even creating the package artwork!

How to Order:

Donwood is accepting orders through the website SeedsfromKids.wordpress.com so that no handling of cash is needed. Seeds from Kids is donating all net proceeds (approximately 90% of the money raised) this year to Donwood School, so **let your family, friends and neighbours know about this fundraiser!** Order deadline is **April**6. Packages will be delivered to your child's classroom in early April. Alternatively, shipping is available at \$5 per mailing.
