#### To register your child, the following information must be provided

#### 2 Pieces Proof of Residency:

- Driver's license
- Manitoba Health Card
- Tenancy agreement (duly signed)
- Offer to purchase documents (completed with signatures)
- Utility bill (name and corresponding address)

#### 1 Piece Proof of Age:

- Birth Certificate
- Passport
- Manitoba Health Card
- Treaty Card
- Baptismal Certificate
- Certificate of Birth registration, signed by Director of Vital Statistics

#### In-Division, Out-of-Designated School Boundary

Parents/Guardians have the ability to make a request that their child attend a school outside their catchment. Parents must submit School of Choice forms with the registration at their designated, catchment school. ### NOTICE RE FEE-FOR-SERVICE BUSING



If you are require Fee-For-Service transportation, the application form must be submitted to the Transportation Dept. <u>each school year</u>. Transportation Application – Fee-For-Service 2022-2023 forms are available from the school office or follow the Quick Link "Busing Information" on the RETSD website at <a href="https://www.retsd.mb.ca">www.retsd.mb.ca</a>

Fee-For-Service applications must be submitted to the Transportation Department by June 30<sup>th</sup> of each school year. Applications received after June 30<sup>th</sup> will be reviewed on an individual basis.




