### **COLDER WEATHER... Reminder**

So far, we have been very lucky with fantastic weather. However, it is beginning to change and when students are not dressed appropriately, 30-minute recess can seem like a long time to be outside! Just a reminder that we can see a difference in temperature during the day, so please make sure the students are dressing in layers. Please have your child dress for the weather including proper wet/winter footwear, headwear, and gloves/mittens. It is very helpful for us when you put your child's name in their boots and clothing! It is important to have the children outside running around getting some exercise, breathing fresh crisp air, and engaging with friends during recess.

### **HALLOWEEN** at school

Our Halloween classroom activities will take place on Thursday Oct. 31. Students are invited to dress up in costumes. When choosing Halloween costumes, please remember that **replica weapons** are **not permitted** at school (this includes replica guns, knives, axes, etc.). Halloween is fast approaching and while we will have opportunities for students to dress up and take part in celebrations and community building, we need to be clear that no one's culture or identity is to be used as a costume. **Costumes that involve cultural appropriation are not acceptable**. Students will be able to bring their own treat to have during their class activity, students are not allowed to share or give any treats to fellow classmates due to numerous allergies and food intolerances at school; **only packaged treats with a list of ingredients** will be allowed at school; or a fruit or veggie.

### **Open House/Meet the Teacher**

Thanks to all parents who came to our Open House/Meet the Teacher this year – it was a fabulous turnout! Thank you to all the parents who signed up to be on either the Parent Association Council or Lunch Program Parent Committee.

#### **PBIS**

Here at École Centrale, we have been/are implementing our classroom treaty within our PBIS framework. This is a division wide initiative. In designing classrooms and our school day, we seek to create spaces and systems that will enable students to be academically and emotionally successful. If we are going to maximize learning opportunities, we must create environments where children are able to process their emotions and transform their inner states. They must be enveloped by a responsive school culture that acknowledges their inner lives as well as their external behaviors and accomplishments.

### A few important items for the upcoming month:

Lunch Program Registrations and Fees are now due. Lunch time at École Centrale is a program fee for service. These fees allow the Lunch Program Committee to determine and hire the number of lunch supervisors during the lunch hour. At present we have 330 students regularly for lunch but only 214 registrations and fees. This means we are short lunch program supervisors for this reason.

### **ATTENDANCE**

If your child is going to be absent or late for school for any reason, please contact the office at **204 – 958 - 6426.** If you are unable to speak to us directly, you may leave a message on the voice mail system to report the absence. Please be specific when calling your child in. If it is an illness, we do need to know **the symptoms** the child is having as well as the best number to reach you at if we have any further questions. Absences are considered "unexcused" if we do not hear from a parent/guardian by 9 am. A student who is absent less than 10 minutes of a day shall be recorded as tar-



dy. Please keep this in mind as you schedule appointments for your children. It is always best to schedule appointments during non-school hours. Students are expected to be in class from 8:20 am to 3:00 pm daily. As a child learns to read and acquires basic math skills, it is important that they practice those new skills daily. Regular attendance promotes new learning. Children begin to learn how to socialize with others, follow directions and solve problems creatively while at school. If a child is not part of the classroom, some of these social skills cannot be practiced. Something to keep in mind, if a child misses two classes a month times ten months that makes 20 days of schooling missed which comes close to whole month.


