

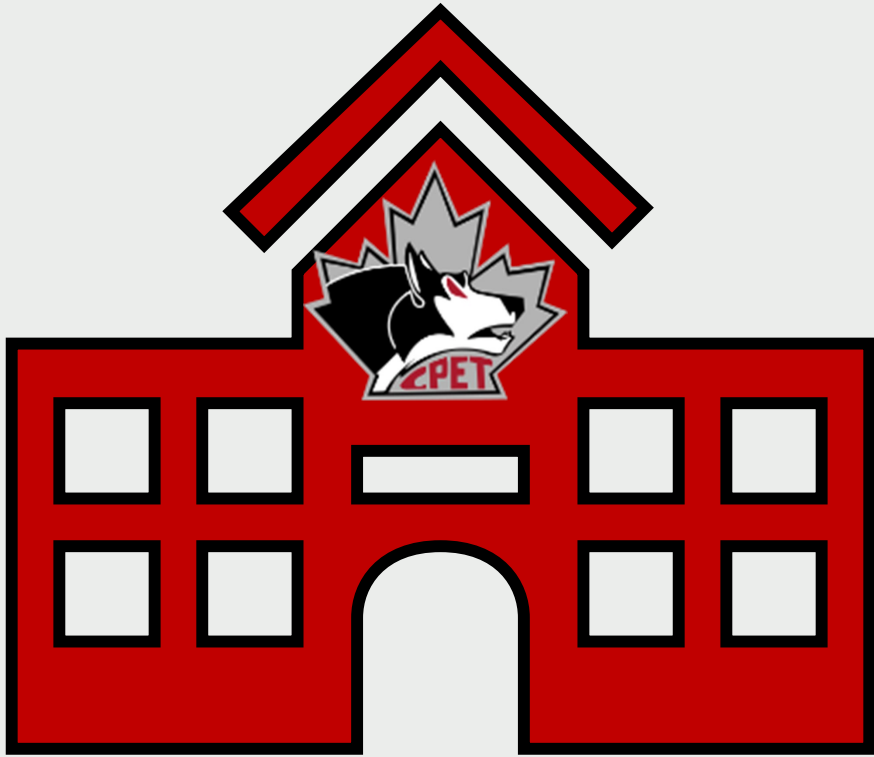

Our School

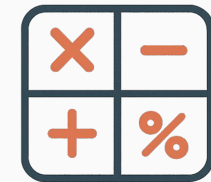
- Approximately **425 students** in **Grades 9-12**

Credit System



30 credits

- ✓ A total of **30 credits** are required to graduate.
- ✓ To receive the Provincial Immersion Diploma, students must earn at least **15 credits** in courses taught in French.
- ✓ A final mark of **50% or higher** is required to earn a credit.
- ✓ Most courses are worth **1 credit**.

Grade 9 Program Organization


- ✓ Each class lasts approximately **65 minutes**.
- ✓ Grade 9 students are fully scheduled throughout the day.
- ✓ Grade 9 students have access to all **clubs** and **extracurricular sports**.
- ✓ The **cafeteria** is open to all students from **10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.** for food purchases.
- ✓ Microwaves are available in the cafeteria throughout the day.
- ✓ All Grade 9 students are assigned to a **homeroom (Teacher Advisory: TA)** - you will meet **once a month** to share information about report cards, conferences, registration, and school-wide lessons throughout the school year.

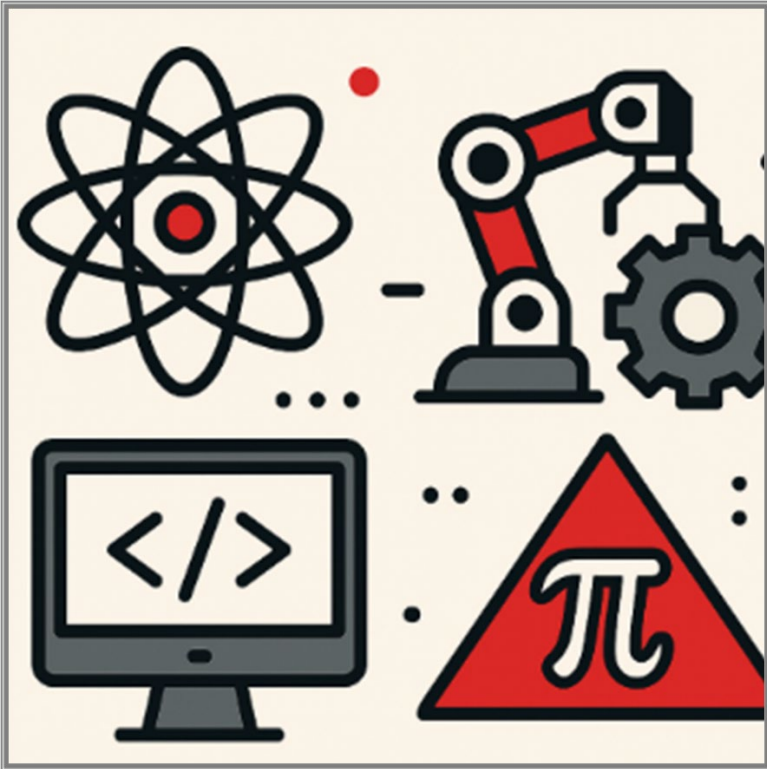
