### **PRINCIPALS' REPORT – Leigh Stachniak**

  - Soccer fields and nets are the next step. Working on finding soccer goals that will be secure enough to endure the weight of students hanging from it without falling and causing injury.
  - Contemplating putting a bridge over the drainage ditch as the work that has already been completed to improve the drainage has already proven to have made a significant difference. Mr. Enns has volunteered to build the bridge if we decide to move forward with it but still need to price out the material.
  - Looking into installing trees and benches to bring shade to the field
  - Still dreaming of a pergola
