#### **FUNDRAISING (Dawn):**

-Have not yet received an invoice because they are still doing a quality control. We sent back 13 closed boxes. There were 9 boxes that were previously opened that will likely get sent back to us. We can sell them throughout the year if needed. There were not that many that were outstanding. Dawn advised Crystal we should send a reminder letter for anything outstanding.

-50/50 application

- -Dawn did send the form in for the Christmas 50/50 draw in October. Dawn has been calling to try to confirm. She reapplied just in case and will follow up. Dawn will advise. We will get this going for this November fundraiser
- -Superbowl: We can run again at this time if we want to, but last meeting we agreed to put out forms to determine interest. Last year we were so successful because we only had 2 winners, if this was not the case, we could have taken a loss. There were people who wanted more books, but people did not return unsold books.
- -We agree to send out the letter to gauge interest. In the meantime, Dawn will apply for the license.

- -OR: Do we want to do this next year instead of chocolates? If we don't use this t as the September fundraiser, we can do it for the October one so we can use it for gifts. Decided to do this for November next year so we can use for Christmas gifts.

- -Halloween dance feedback: Parker did great. Becky was working the canteen and found that some of the kids were struggling with math. Usually there are teachers standing behind them, but this year did not. Becky and Lezah were there helping most of the time. Would have been nice to have teachers there.
- -Halloween parade feedback: It was not really a parade, the kids did not circle around so nobody got to see the costumes. They used to walk around the room, then sit, so everyone has a chance to show their costumes. There was also music played. Andy agrees and will use this feedback for next year.
- -Christmas Shop, set up wed 11:45-3:30 Dec 11 (kindergarten at end of day) and Dec 12, Thursday all day
- -Volunteer: Dec 11<sup>th</sup>: Lynn, Becky, Nicole. Be here for 9am to bring in stuff and start setting up.
- -Dec 12: Volunteer: Usually grade 5's will come help the younger kids. They rotate groups/classes. Lynn, Sandi, Dawn, Becky.
  - -We will extend the wrapping tables this year and have more of them.
- -Anita already sent out an email. Becky will post on Facebook. Where do we want to keep the donations, Andy will find a spot we can do the photocopy room.
- -Lynn asked: Can people make monetary donations instead of donating supplies? Yes they can. The money can be used to purchase bags, supplies and such. Any surplus could be put towards the gift cards at the end of the Christmas shop. Or the money can go towards the stuff for the Christmas hamper.

- -Popcorn day Nov 15, supplies and volunteers (Crystal and Lezah not avail): Becky and Richard.
  - -Lezah bought supplies. Volunteers: Richard, Becky

- -Lynn suggests: There was a form last time with the popcorn orders for the teachers which was really helpful. There was either the grade or the classroom number that could be added on the form that would be very helpful.
- -Volunteers Needed for November 21 1 per classroom ideal See above
- -Holiday Concert treat for students (kernels popcorn, or any other ideas?) If you go with kernels Crystal can order and pick up on Sunday Dec 15 and we can bag it on the 16<sup>th</sup>. But Crystal won't be available to bag it. And need volunteer to pick up bags. If you go with another idea, let me know how Crystal can assist.
  - -We agree to do Kernels again. Becky will order 3 bags for the x-mas concert.
- -The bags split though last year. Buy bags and Dollarama (NOT dollar tree). Need to get them soon because they sell out. Can get Christmas zip lock bags instead, better idea. Becky will pick up treat bags. Crystal will order Kernels, Becky will pick up on Sunday and bag it Dec 16<sup>th</sup>. Volunteers to bag: Dawn and Becky
  - -We might have an allergy to the red dye. We will figure out what to order.
- -Did we ever get the karaoke machine as a prize for the dance? Andy checked the room and we do not have it here. Dawn will contact Hugh again and let him know that we accidentally seen the opened boxes back, and as an fyi we have not yet received our karaoke prize he said we can have.
- -The elephant swing is here, they dropped it off the other day. He needs a special tool. A technician is supposed to be coming here. The repairs should have been under warranty. Should we repair now? Because it could be cold and crack, also it is dangerous in the winter because they slide under it too. Let's wait until the spring. Andy will follow up. And we need to keep that special tool.
- -Lynn has a question about parent teacher: the forms indicate if you want to speak to a specialist, but the report cards come out after this form, so how would we know if we need to see a specialist. The online version will fix this, but for now this is how it is.
