In order of Priority:

## FUNDRAISING (Dawn):

-Review ideas:
-Superbowl We could have ready around the Christmas concert so families can pick up then, or have a sin up sheet to gauge interest. Would there be possible confusion with the 50/50 fundraiser? Superbowl is February 2, so we could put sign-up sheets to gauge interest with the $50 / 50$ letter and can send back. However, it is a crazy time of year. We will gauge interest for now, we can send the letter out now and make an announcement at the Halloween dance. If there is not enough response, we don't do it. Response cut off is November 15.

-Lezah bought popcorn supplies but did not submit receipts yet.
Requests: 1) Recess Equipment: Outdoor supplies (football, soccer ball, tether ball etc...). There will be a sin in/out sheet for kits using supplies. The order has already been put in, can PAC contribute? Cost broken down is $\$ 436$ for equipment plus the cost for 10 bins $=\$ 500$. Approved to give money from PAC by Dawn (first) and Sandi (Second).
2) Kindergarten Class Supplies: Learning-stimulus toys, and water table. Cost \$740. PAC approved to donate the whole amount. Approved by Nicole (first) and Sandi (second).
-Note: Kindergarten class has more kits, so teachers account has some extra money.

-There should be someone manning the doors at least for a couple minutes after the bell. Andy will look into changing the door-lock procedure.
