1. Patrol Safety

- A PAC member shared concerns over patrol safety with vehicles.
- Was discussed that a possible solution may be to place a cone/pylon on the driveway of the home adjacent to the school property.
- The patrol captain could be responsible for dropping off and picking up of the cone.
- Ryan will contact home owner regarding placing cones in the driveway to increase children safety.

2. Bothwell Cheese Fundraiser

3. Hot Lunch
