Safe Grad Guidelines

It is a plan to organize an enjoyable but accident and incident free graduation celebration. The purpose of a SAFE GRAD program is to eliminate accidents, death and misfortune by promoting safe practices among young people so as not to experience difficulty with alcohol, vapes, and drugs.

Absolute rules under an Approved SAFE GRAD:

- No grads are allowed to drive.
- No Student/guest will be allowed to sign out of SAFE GRAD without a designated driver present.
- No one under the age of 18 is permitted to consume alcohol
- Parents volunteering are not allowed to consume alcohol

Ticket Sales

Tickets will be available for students, guest and unlimited family starting in May. Students may have one guest only stay for the safe grad.

It is possible to both volunteer and attend the dinner. Please choose a volunteer shift outside of the dinner hours.(6:30-8:30)

Tables will be formed in groups of 10. There will be a seating chart available for students to view on Teams. Table arrangements will be first come first served (date will be in June to select).

Parents/family wishing to attend the dinner and dance may sit with their student or form parent tables.



Ticket Sales continued...

Students' accessibility to choosing seat will be on hold until:

- 1) The Safe grad contract form is received and processed.
- 2) Any outstanding materials and fees are cleared (see office)
- 3) Ticket is paid.

The deadline for the safe grad contract is on **May 8th. Forms will be collected the week of April 29th – May 8th. In person at school.**

If the form is submitted after **May 8th, 2026**, it will result in a \$25 late fee and the processing will be delayed. It will not be accepted after June 1st.

Parent Chair

1 Parent is needed – **position filled**

- Connect with committee Chairs to assess the volunteer needs of each committee.
- Recruit and co-ordinate parents for volunteer help as required.
- Attend Safe Grad meeting at the Convention Centre (**Thursday, March 5, 2026 at 5:30 pm**)
- Attend the event for the entire duration (on June 23th, 2026).





Fundraising Chair

Organize an online 50/50 fundraiser from January – March.





Sign in/out

30+ parents are needed.

- Attend the Safe Grad event shifts:(Sign In) 5:00 - 6:30, (During) 6:30-8:30, 8:30-10:30, (Sign Out)10:30 until the end.
- Sign in all attendees (wristbands) & signing out with a verified designated driver.
- All materials will be provided.

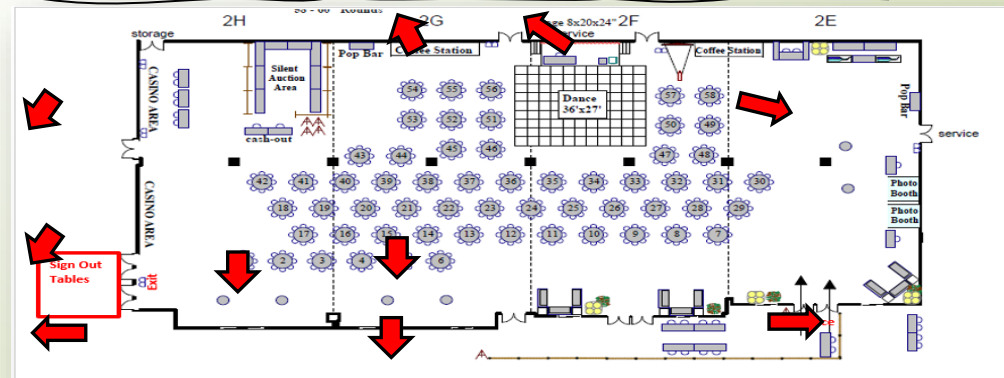




Supervision/Security

40+ parents are needed.

- Attend the Safe Grad event during shifts: 5:00-8:00, 8:00-10:30, and 10:30 until the end.
- Maintain your assigned position within the venue.
- Regularly check the washrooms.
- Assist in resolving any issues, such as drama among students or helping those who have over-indulged.
- Work with venue security as required.





Fun Casino

26+ parents are needed.

- Attend Safe Grad event during shifts 8:30-10:00, 10:00-11:30.
- Operate one table as a dealer; one night of training will be provided before (the week before grad)
- Not responsible for the delivery, setup, and take down.
- One night training (30 mins +) before the event
 - 9 Blackjack tables
 - 2 wheels of chance
 - 2 poker tables





Raffle

10+ parents are needed.

- Campaign to obtain silent raffle prizes. (letter provided)
- Organize prizes into packages and set them up at the venue.
- Monitor and exchange casino funds for raffle tickets during the event.
- Announce the winners at ~11:30 pm (e.g., Record the names of the winners on a large paper.)





Medical

1-2 parents are needed.

- Medical experience is an asset but not required.
- Pre-screen/flag safe grad forms for medical alerts
- Assist with any medical issues (sickness, band-aid, etc.)
- Contact paramedic (911) and parent(s) in case of emergency.





Grad Breakfast

15+ parents are needed.

- The breakfast menu will be catered.
- Seeking donations for items like prizes, coffee, juice, and other related expenses.
- Adding fruit platters, baked goods, or table "snacks" is always welcome.
- Decorating the cafeteria the day before: Set up tables and chairs
- Taking tickets on the morning of the breakfast (selling the grad breakfast tickets will be handled by the school, and a list of students who have purchased tickets will be provided).
- Serve breakfast in an orderly manner (e.g., using table numbers).
- Clean up after the event.
