RULES AND REGULATIONS



1. Admission to the Grad Dinner and Dance is limited to graduates, one paid invited guest, parents/guardians and other family members. Supervisors at the door will have a list of approved attendees. No one will be allowed in without his/her name being on the attendee list.
2. Admission to the Safe Grad Party is limited to graduates and one paid invited guest. No one under the age of 16 may attend the Safe Grad Party. Supervisors at the door will have a list of approved graduates and guests. No one will be allowed in without his/her name being on the master list.
3. Graduates and guests 18 years of age and older will be identified with a wristband. Photo ID is required: only Manitoba Liquor and Lotteries sanctioned forms of ID will be accepted. Out-of-province guests must produce **two** pieces of identification (one must be photo ID).
4. Only 18+ wrist-banded persons may purchase alcohol. Bar service is restricted to the purchase of two drinks at a time. Bar service is restricted to the purchase of two drinks at a time. ***It is illegal to purchase alcoholic beverages for minors and will not be permitted.*** Venue staff, at their discretion, may refuse to serve anyone who has "had too much to drink."
5. **Those with 18+ wristbands must carry their ID at all times.** They will be required to show their ID again as they enter TYC Event Centre and Canad Inns staff may request to see ID at any time during the event.
6. Graduates are responsible for their own and their guests' behavior. If the graduate leaves, his/her guest must also leave; however, if the guest leaves, the graduate will not have to leave.
7. **Everyone, regardless of how much he/she has had or not had to drink, will be driven home by his/her Designated Driver.** If the graduate and/or guest wish to leave early, the Designated Driver will be notified to pick them up, and they may not return. Designated Drivers must be 21 years of age or older.
8. No alcohol may be brought into the Safe Grad venues. **Bags will be searched and must be placed in the Coat Check.** It is the hotel policy that attendees may be subject to pat-down searches by hotel security as they enter the TYC Event Centre. Safe Grad parent security, hotel security, and the Winnipeg Police will be in attendance.
9. The bar for the Dinner and Dance will open after dinner and speeches and will close at 12:00 midnight. At the TYC Event Centre Safe Grad Party, the bar will close at 3:00 a.m. The tables will be cleared by 4:00 a.m.
10. Any person involved in a fight or any other aggressive physical or verbal behaviour, either as an instigator or retaliator, will be sent home. Their designated driver will be notified to pick them up immediately.
11. Non-alcoholic drinks (pop and water) will be available at all times.
12. No parent/guardian will allow a party, with alcohol available, to be planned prior to or after the Safe Grad event as this defeats the purpose of the Safe Grad planning concept.
13. Graduates, their guests, and family members may not book a room at Canad Inns Polo Park on June 28, 2019.
