Dear Parent / Guardian:

Please find attached our Registration Form for the Sherwood School Lunch Program for the 2025 / 2026 school year. Students are required to bring their own lunch and are supervised in the classrooms and outside for recess time. We encourage you to read through the Policies and Expectations which were emailed to you and can also be found on the Sherwood School website. The Policies and Expectations explain our program and contain important information.

Here are a few things to note (detailed information is found in the Policies and Expectations):

- Every child staying to be supervised at Sherwood School during the lunch break, **even once**, needs to be registered with the Sherwood School Lunch Program (SSLP) and the daily user fee will apply.
- The full-time user fee for 2025 / 2026 will be \$232.50 per year per child, based on \$1.25 per day per child. Please see the Registration Form for user fee payment options for Kindergarten to Grade 5 students.

As our program is designed to break even (not run a surplus) and at this time the fee is mandated to be per child per day, it is critical that fees be paid on time. Without this we cannot pay our supervisors, and, in that event, the program cannot continue (i.e. parents will need to make out of school arrangements for their children.) Please help us out by keeping your fees paid up, on time.

There are three options for **full-time lunch supervision for students who stay at school 3-5 days a week**. Please review these on the fee-payment information page attached.

Casual lunch program students are students who **consistently stay 1-2 days or less/week**. These students will always be billed at the end of the month and payment must be made between 1-5 days of receiving the invoice.

Please complete a family registration form for your child(ren) and return the form **along with the appropriate payment, as applicable**, to the school office **by Friday, September 12, 2025**. Students who are not registered in the program by this time will not be permitted to stay for lunch until the registration is received.
