Wanting to honour all School Trustees, Superintendents and Secretary-Treasurers who have served before us, we began the process of creating and dedicating plaques with their names, which can be found in the board room of the River East Transcona School Division Administration Offices. From there, the project expanded and efforts were made to collect as much historical information as possible to ensure it would not be lost to time.

Further research began: searching through historical documentation; spending many hours going through minute books; visits to the Legislative Library, Manitoba Archives, and Winnipeg Library; and online research. As well, there were hours of personal contact over the phone with former Trustees, employees, and their families. The most enjoyable part of the research was often the discovery of photos, moments in time that brought faces to names; then, a voice on the other end of the phone would bring a personal story to a photo and the person within it.

This book is our way to honour all those who served in our legacy divisions. It's not only a history of the division, but hopefully also tells a story and gives a pictorial showing what we looked like back when we first began. After all, knowing where we've come from helps us to appreciate our heritage and understand how our community has changed and grown.

Referendum

After a referendum of the resident electors, where the majority voted in favour of the establishment of a new school division, the Minister of Education established River East School Division No. 9 on February 28, 1959, through subsections 1 of sections 435, 436 and 442 of The Public Schools Act.

The Minister of Education had three parts to the order, as follows:

- 1. "That a school division be established on the 1st day of April 1959, to be styled and known as the River East School Division No. 9 comprising all the lands that may from time to time be included in the school districts named in section 2 hereof."
- 2. "That the division be divided into 4 wards which shall be comprised of the lands in the school districts as set out in the following table."

Ward 1—School District of East Kildonan No. 14

Ward 2—School District of North Kildonan No. 2116

Ward 3—School District of McIvor No. 2323

Ward 4—Municipal School District of East St. Paul No. 2322 School District of Donald No. 1094



In 1967, by declaration of the Minister of Education, elections for School Boards would be held on March 31, 1967, and the boards would take office as of April 1, 1967.

In 1974, Trustee terms changed from January–December to November–October. As a result of these changes, two Trustees could have served as Chairman of the board in 1974; one from January–October and the other starting in November of that same year.



In 1967, by declaration of the Minister of Education, elections for School Boards would be held on March 31, 1967, and would take office as of April 1, 1967.



River East School Division No. 9 April 1, 1959–June 30, 2002

On November 8, 2001, Education, Training and Youth Minister Drew Caldwell announced the amalgamation of some school divisions in the province, pursuant to The Public Schools Act and Manitoba Regulation 116/2002, Implementation of School Division and School District Amalgamation. The number of school divisions would be reduced from 54 to 37.

The government announced that River East School Division would be amalgamated with the urban portion of Transcona-Springfield School Division (west of the floodway). The amalgamation would come into effect July 1, 2002.

After 43 years of existence, River East School Division No. 9 shut its doors.



The following pages contain the history of Transcona-Springfield School Division No. 12 from its inception on April 1, 1959 to its dissolution on June 30, 2002.

Referendum

After a referendum of the resident electors, where the majority voted in favour of the establishment of a new school division, the Minister of Education established Transcona-Springfield School Division No. 12 on February 28, 1959, through subsections 1 of sections 435, 436 and 442 of The Public Schools Act.

The Minister of Education had three parts to the order, as follows:

- 1. "That a school division be established on the 1st day of April 1959, to be styled and known as the Transcona-Springfield School Division No. 12 comprising all the lands that may from time to time be included in the school districts named in section 2 hereof."
- 2. "That the division be divided into 4 wards which shall be comprised of the lands in the school districts as set out in the following table."

Transcona-Springfield School Division No. 12

April 1, 1959-June 30, 2002

On November 8, 2001, Education, Training and Youth Minister Drew Caldwell announced the amalgamation of some school divisions in the province, pursuant to The Public Schools Act and Manitoba Regulation 116/2002, Implementation of School Division and School District Amalgamation. The number of school divisions would be reduced from 54 to 37.

The government announced that Transcona-Springfield School Division would be split. The urban portion of the division (west of the floodway) would amalgamate with River East School Division. The rural portion of the division (east of the floodway) would amalgamate with Agassiz School Division. The amalgamation would come into effect July 1, 2002.

After 43 years of existence, Transcona-Springfield School Division No. 12 shut its doors.
