Remote Learning FAQ

We recognize this school year has been, and will likely continue to be, unlike any we've had in the past. As such, we hope to establish some guiding principles by which school boards can anticipate how claims are handled while students are learning remotely.

Q: Is the student covered for remote learning while on a live call with a teacher or school staff member?

A: Yes – this would be considered an activity or learning experience approved and supervised by the appropriate authority of the Policyholder.

Q: Is the student covered for remote learning while watching a pre-recorded video?

A: No – given there is no direct supervising authority from the school, coverage would not be extended to the student during this activity or learning experience.

Q: Is the student covered while in the process of completing assignments independently during school hours?

A: No – again, given the students are not on school premises by reason of attending classes, or being supervised by an approved authority of the school, coverage would not be extended to the student.

Q: Is the student covered while in the process of completing normal homework after school hours?

A: No – given the student is not on school premises by reason of attending classes, or being supervised by an approved authority of the school, coverage would not be extended to the student.
