Principal's Report - R. Reyes

It's June!!! This year has truly flown by! A huge thank to our Wonderful WSCC from our Wayoata staff, students, and families for the tremendous dedication, time, planning, and effort you have put in this year to allow our school community to enjoy dances, movie nights, fundraisers, field trips, and more! Your dedication to and support for our school is deeply appreciated!

- 1. Staff Professional Learning During our coordinated day coming up on June 9, our teachers will be engaging in professional dialogue at grade level teams, to share information about students' strengths and needs, with the students' teachers for 2025-2026. Teachers will also be working in committee groups, reflecting on the current year's school plan and preparing for the plans they have laid out for the coming year.
- 2. Staffing for 2025-2026 Our teacher staffing is remaining nearly status quo for the coming school year. We will be continuing with our historical staffing of 2 student services teachers, however rather than 2 fulltime resource teachers, we are moving to 1 fulltime resource teacher and one teacher who will work as halftime resource and halftime counselor. We are very excited for how a counseling component will be able to support our students and families.

At this point in time, we are projected to have 2 kindergarten classes again this coming year.

We are bidding farewell to a few teachers who are exploring opportunities at different levels (middle/senior years) or in other buildings, and we are also welcoming some new teachers to Wayoata School!
