It's been a great first two months of learning, and we are already nearing the end of Term 1! We appreciate all of the families who were able to connect with teachers either inperson or online to celebrate their children's learning during our Learning Conferences last week.

- Picture Retake Day Our Picture Retake Day went well on October 19th, with Edge Imaging. Edge will be returning in the Spring for group/class photos.
- 2. Halloween Dance A huge thank you to WSCC for hosting a very successful Halloween Dance at Wayoata! Our students and families were all smiles (and sweat!) as they left after a great night of dancing, treats, and prize draws!
- **3. Learning Conferences** We want to thank all families who booked a time to attend their child's learning conference, whether in person or virtual! We had approximately 75% of our families engage in important celebration and conversation with their child and classroom teacher, to support student success at Wayoata.
- 4. Extracurricular Activities
 - a. Student Voice Club Our 3/4/5 Student Voice Club, collected nearly 300 pairs of socks during our Socktober sock drive! Now they're taking on a Koats for Kids drive, hoping to collect lots of gently used children's outerwear to donate to this important cause! They are also beginning to think ahead to collecting and organizing food and gift items for 2-3 Christmas Hampers.

Mr. McPherson, with the help of many teachers, have been organizing songs, lines, scripts, roles, costumes, and more, to prepare for a great show! Our students are already working hard in music, choir, and during additional rehearsals!
